1. This was awarded in 1155 to the town of Wallingford by Henry 11.
2. These hills are known by many as the Wittenham Clumps.
3. A young nobleman.
4. He was the Saxon Lord of Wallingford in 1066.
5. This Brian, was also a Lord of Wallingford.
6. Wallingford's - - - - - was built by one of William the Conqueror's knights, Robert D'Oiley.
7. A notable Judge with Wallingford connections.
8. One of the people who were living in Wallingford before the Normans.
9. Sounds like Sir Henry - - - - - who was granted the Constablership of Wallingford Castle by Henry V111
10. One of the 1066 invaders.
